

2014 NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL

The annual National Law Enforcement Memorial events recognize the sacrifices of Federal, State, local & tribal law enforcement officers who gave the last full measure of devotion. The 2014 event begins on Monday, May 12, with an afternoon practice session and continues on Tuesday, May 13, with a morning and afternoon practice session for the USCGPB pipe band and honor guards, location TBD. All the band performances will be on Wednesday, May 14.

The majority of events revolve around the area north and northwest of Capitol Hill.

USCGPB – Tentative PRACTICE & PERFORMANCE ITINERARY

Monday, May 12	1500 to 1900, Band rehearsal TBD at location on Joint Base Anacostia/Boling (JBAB) Muster at 1445 in Commissary & PX parking lot as marked on map
Tuesday, May 13	0900 to 1200, Band rehearsal 1330 to 1800, Band rehearsal JBAB (specific location TBD)
Wednesday, May 14	0700 Muster, PX parking lot 1000, Band Competition 1330 (aprox.) FOP Tent City 1800, Parade & Memorial Service

Note: There will be a Memorial Ceremony at the U.S. Capitol on Thursday, May 15, 1100 hrs, for those who can and wish to attend. Muster at 0900 at the PX parking lot.

USCGPB – LODGING & ARRIVAL

Lodging reservations can begin 30 days prior to your arrival date, so the earliest you can start calling is 11 April (if you arrive 11 May etc). YOU MUST HAVE SOME TYPE OF MILITARY ID CARD TO STAY IN MILITARY LODGING. Any rooms that have not been reserved by **April 27, 2014**, they will be released from the room block.

The JBAB Lodging Reservations process has changed since last year. Please call and reserve the room with the following **GROUP ID#: 31480100968** by calling **1-877-NAVYBED** (628-9233) or through their website: <u>www.dodlodging.net</u>. When calling please indicate you need a room reservation as a component of the USCG Pipe Band. You will need to guarantee your room with a credit card.

Directions to the JBAB Lodging Office

The Lodging Office is open 24 hrs/day. From the Main Gate, go LEFT at the first cross street, Brooklyn Ave SW, turn LEFT on McChord St, go about a block & turn RIGHT on Duncan St, go about one Block and turn LEFT on Thesen St. The Lodging Reservations office is on the RIGHT at 602 Thesen, Bldg 52. (You can also Google map the location for Bolling AFB).

Driving Arrival - Joint Base Anacostia/Bolling

Many of us intend to drive to the event and according to the base access information, visitors, guests, and vendors reporting to JBAB are required to report to the South Gate to gain access to the base with the following information. With a military ID card or other US Government ID, you should also be able to also use the Main Gate (Arnold Gate).

South Gate location - Overlook Ave. and Chappie James Blvd off I-295 (2 miles north of I-495) South Gate Hours - 0500 - 2100 hrs

Main Gate (Arnold Gate) location - Malcolm X Blvd exit off I-295 (about 3 miles north of I-495) Main Gate Hours – 24 hours

- The main gate is open to all with Controlled Access Cards (CAC), military ID, or other US Government ID. The South gate is open to CAC holders, as well to all non-CAC holders, visitors, & guests.
- Vehicles <u>may</u> require a valid DOD Registration Decal or Temporary Vehicle Pass for access to the installation.
- A valid Driver's License, Proof of Insurance and Registration is required to obtain a Temporary Vehicle Pass. If you are planning to rent a vehicle and drive on base, you will still need military ID/US Government ID and the rental agreement.

Getting to Joint Base Anacostia/Bolling

Joint Base Anacostia/Bolling/ (JBAB) is a combination of the previously well-known Bolling AFB and Anacostia Naval Air Station and conveniently located to DC at the confluence of the Anacostia and Potomac Rivers.

From the south, JBAB can be reached off of I-295 going north from I-495 just east of the Potomac River or from the north traveling south on the Baltimore-Washington Parkway (BW Pkwy turns into I-295) from I-495.There is METRO service on the **GREEN LINE** but JBAB is not within walking distance of the METRO stop. There is MARC train service from BWI to Union Station (where you catch the

METRO), and for folks coming into Dulles, there is an express Metro Bus (5A) for \$6 that drops off at the Rosslyn Metro Station and the L'Enfant Metro Station, with two intermediate stops at Tyson's and Herndon. The closest and probably safest METRO stop to hail a cab would be Navy Yard on the **GREEN** LINE.

JBAB is directly across the river from Reagan National airport and cab fare is approximately \$20. Cab fare from BWI or Dulles International would be approximately \$75-100.

Airports

If you can, please make any flight arrangements to arrive at Reagan National Airport. If you plan to rent a car and will not need transport from the airport, please inform BMCS Cochran or CDR Hines. Arrangements have been made to pick people up at Reagan National airport, if needed.

- Washington Reagan National 8 miles from Bolling AFB
- Baltimore Washington International 35 miles from Bolling AFB
- Dulles International 35 miles from Bolling AFB

USCGPB – PRACTICE LOCATION, UNIFORMS, EVENT TRNSPORTATION, & MEALS

Practice locations - Muster

ALL personnel should muster at the Commissary/PX parking lot at 1445 on Monday, 12 May (in parking area closest to the road and marked on enclosed map). We will determine at that time whether to practice in or outdoors.

Uniforms

Bring for use the Service Dress Blue (Bravo) uniform and the Tropical Blue uniforms. The Bravo uniform will be the primary uniform for all events.

- Bravo kit coat, ribbons, CGPB nametag, light blue shirt, blue neck/tab tie, kilt, blue hose, red flashes, white spats, black uniform shoes, Glengarry, glen device, blue hackle, belt & buckle, and sporran.
- Tropical Blue (kilt) light blue short-sleeve shirt, V-neck white T-shirt, ribbons, rank devices, CGPB nametag, kilt, blue hose, red flashes, white spats, black uniform shoes, glengarry, glen device, blue hackle, belt & buckle, and sporran.

Transportation

Daily transport from JBAB to the events will be by USCG passenger vans provided by USCG HQ and we provide our own drivers. Departure muster times and any event specifics will be communicated at the band practice on Mon, 12 May.


Meals
